General Information:

1. The horse show committee, nor Blue Valley Riding Center, LLC will not be responsible for any damages, injury, or loss of persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Hard hats must be worn at all times while riding at Blue Valley Riding Center, LLC. Hard hats with attached harnesses must be worn by all junior riders.
3. No junior rider may ride or handle stallions.
4. All dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times.
5. Current negative coggins required.
6. The Committee reserves the right to cancel when in its judgment, the entries are inadequate or combine, change location or add a schooling if deemed necessary.
7. Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing. In the event of a division tie, the tie breaker will be determined by the over fence classes.
8. A processing fee of \$40 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. It will be expected that any returned checks will be 'made good' within 10 days from notice.
9. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.

M&S Adult 2'6 Medal: Open to Adult riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at 2'6 including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. May only be combined with the Children's 2'6 Medal. Fences at 2'6.

M&S Children's Hunter Horse Classic: Open to Junior riders not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences with at least one change of direction after the first fence. A combination is encouraged. At least three horses must complete the course in order for points to count. Rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. Score from the third round of the Children's Hunter Horse/Adult Hunter division will be combined with the score from the classic round to determine placing. May be combined with the Children's Pony Hunter classic.

M&S Children's Pony Hunter Classic: Open to Junior riders not competing in any class at the same show in which the fences exceed 2'6. To be shown over a course of 8 fences with at least one change of direction after the first fence. Fences will be at 2'6 for large ponies, 2' for small/medium ponies. Only one rider per horse. At least three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. Rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. Score from the third jumping round of the Children's Pony Hunter division will be combined with the score from the Classic round to determine placing. May be combined with the Children's Hunter Horses and/or Children's Hunter Pony classics.

M&S Adult Hunter Classic: Open to Adult Amateur riders not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences with at least one change of direction after the first fence. A combination is encouraged. At least three horses must complete the course in order for points to count. Rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. Score from the third round of the Children's Hunter Horse/Adult Hunter division will be combined with the score from the classic round to determine placing. May be combined with the Children's Pony Hunter Classic.

Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic: A 2'6 classic for the Novice-type child and adult rider. Must be held as a separate, two round classic (i.e. the first round may not be a designated class of a division). Open to Junior or Amateur riders. NO cross entry of horse/pony in to the M&S Children's Horse, Pony, or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider in to any rated hunters or any class with fences of 3' or higher.

All M&S Classes: \$35

Hunter Derby: \$40/entry

M&S Class Specifications (\$35/class)

M&S Children's Medal Pony: Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fence at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional, and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal at the same show. (Fence heights above are suggested, and should be used whenever possible. If Children's Hunter Pony specifications differ, Show management may offer fence heights according to those specifications.)

M&S Dover Saddlery Adult Medal: Open to Adult Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

Sore No More Children's Horse Medal: Open to Junior riders on horses that are not competing in any Hunter or Equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least 2 changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four combinations are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three rides must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. NO cross entry of rider into the Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with the Adult and/or Pony Medal. Fences at 3'.

M&S Children's 2'6 Medal: Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at 2'6 including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the finals. No cross entry of rider in to the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May only be combined with the M&S 2'6 Adult Medal. Fences at 2'6.

Class Specifications

Leadline: Open to riders 3 – 6 years of age. May not cross over to any other riding class, or forfeit lead line eligibility. May show in any in hand class with discretion of parent/guardian. Apparent ability of the rider to control the mount is a contributing factor in judging the suitability of the mount to rider. Attire of rider must conform to style of riding. Child is not to be fastened to the saddle in any way. No Junior Exhibitor may handle a mount with a Lead line rider.

Mini-Stirrups: Open to exhibitors 10 years of age and under as of 12/1/2017. Riders may not cross enter into any canter classes however they may cross enter into ALL Walk/Trot classes. Division is shown at Walk/Trot.

Short-Stirrups: Open to exhibitors 12 years of age and under as of 12/1/2017 and who have not shown over a course of 2' fences. May cross enter into Open Beginner, Walk/Trot Classes and Walk/Trot/Canter flat classes. May not show in Hunter Hack 2'. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Long- Stirrup: Open to exhibitors 13 years of age and over as of 12/1/2017 and who have not shown a course of 2' fences, Riders may cross enter into Open Beginner (if eligible), Walk/Trot division and any flat classes. May not show in Hunter Hack 2'. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Open Walk/Trot: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a Junior or Senior exhibitor.

Novice Equitation: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a Junior or Amateur exhibitor who has not won 3 blue ribbons in equitation the previous show year. To show over a course of eight (8) or more fences not to exceed 2'. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Modified Hunter: Open to Juniors and Amateurs riding horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of eight (8) or more fences. Fence height of 2'. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Pleasure Horse/Pony: Open to all riders, horses and ponies.

Introducing:

TRIPLE STAKES CLASSES

1A. Star Buick GMC Triple Stakes W/T

Pleasure: \$20/entry Open to all. To be shown at the W/T both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Judged on manners, way of going and suitability to give a pleasurable ride.

2A. Blue Seal Triple Stakes Pleasure Hack:

\$20/entry Open to all. To be shown at the W/T/C both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Judged on manners, way of going and suitability to give a pleasurable ride.

3A. Shoreline Saddlery Triple Stakes 2'6

Hunter Derby: \$40/entry Open to all. The Hunter Derby is designed to resemble the hunt field with brush jumps and natural fences. Its purpose is to return hunters to their hunt-field roots. This particular Hunter Derby will consist of ten fences at 2'6" and you may be required to jump out of the ring over a brush-like fence. There will also be option fences that will be set at 3' and the horse/rider combination can earn extra points by taking the higher options.

Each class will receive a specialty prize by the class sponsor in addition to a cash prize.

Payout will be as follows: First place will receive 25% of entries, second place will receive 15% of entries, and third place will receive 10% of entries.

Baby Green: Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over a course of 8 fences. Adults may ride ponies, suitability to count. Rider has the option of showing at 2' or 2'3". To be shown over a course of eight (8) fences. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Hunt Pairs: \$20/entry. Open to horses and ponies with rider of any age. To be judged on performance, soundness, and timing with an emphasis on manners. To be shown over a course of fences at 2'. Final fence to be "side-by-side". No oxers to be included in a 2' class.

Children's Pony/Horse/Adult Hunter: Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. Small/medium ponies jump 2', large ponies jump 2'6", horses jump 3'. Third O/F class will be the first round of the M&S Hunter Classic.

Low Hunter: Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. To be shown over a course of fences at 2'3". To be shown over a course of eight (8) fences.

Junior/Adult Equitation: Open to all non-professionals. Riders may choose to show at either 2'3" or 2'6".

Pre-Children's/Low Adult Hunter: Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Judged on manners, way of going and suitability. Riders may not cross enter into any classes that fence heights exceeds 2'6".
